ADVANCE DIRECTIVES

An advance directive is a written statement about future medical care if you no longer can speak for yourself, formerly known as a ,Living Will.' You can also designate someone to make decisions for you if you become incapacitated. Forms may be obtained from most hospitals, healthcare organizations, many attorneys' offices or UHELP. Other documents, including Comfort Care Only/Do Not Resuscitate I.D. bracelets or necklaces, give instructions to health care personnel in emergencies. Forms may be obtained from the Emergency Medical Services Section, State Department of Health at 733-9210 or download at www.Hawaii.gov/health/family-child-health.




