Re-use Hawaii

Re-use Hawai'i was founded in 2007 as a solution to Oahu's solid waste problem. More than one third of Oahu's waste comes from unnecessary construction and demolition debris.

Salvaging material for reuse conserves resources and energy, reduces waste, creates jobs, and transforms waste into a resource. Re-use Hawai'i diverts tons of reusable building material from landfills each week and makes this material available to the public at extremely affordable prices.

Our Kakaako warehouse is centrally located in downtown Honolulu and open to the public 7 days a week.



State of Hawaii, Department of Health Deposit Beverage Container Program

“Since January 2005, Hawaii’s Deposit Beverage Container (DBC) program has assisted residents to recycle over 7 billion containers. Through recycling, consumers are helping to remove these containers from the waste stream and also reducing litter in the community.

The DBC program certifies independent recycling companies to operate Certified Redemption Centers (CRCs) statewide. These CRCs provide Hawaii consumers with refunds of the 5¢ deposit fee that is paid for eligible containers.”
